The Hustle for Hunger, in support of the Agape Table, is hoping to gain support of the Corydon Avenue BIZ and its member businesses. Founded in 1980, Agape Table was established to serve free hot meals to people in Winnipeg's inner city. 30 years later, Agape Table still serves over 350 hot breakfasts each day – many to children - without qualification

or judgement. Agape Table offers much more than emergency food. As

a community nutrition centre, Agape believes there is hope in nutrition, there is dignity in choice, and there is power in food. Unfortunately, Agape Table does not receive financial support from government, and they rely on the community to meet the need.

The Hustle for Hunger is a 3 km walk, 5 km or 10 km run event with over 200 participants taking part each year. The fundraising goal for this, our 8th year, is \$10,000. Achieving this goal will require the support of many, and we are asking you to consider committing your support to this worthy cause. All proceeds go directly to Agape Table.


